HOW TO STUDY ABROAD

RESEARCH

Review your remaining UCLA degree requirements (GE, pre-major, major, minor, foreign language, & upper division units).

IDENTIFY

Find UCEAP courses and identify options that are comparable to your degree requirements. They do not have to be an exact match.



DISCUSS

If you have questions, meet the advisors at the International Education Office to review program details and locate syllabi.



PETITION

Petition with your Anthropology advisor to apply study abroad coursework toward your degree requirements.

- Pre-approvals are provided by the Anthropology department. Therefore, you will know before your program starts whether you will be receiving credit for coursework.
- Of note, all coursework you plan to take abroad and apply toward GE credit must be presented to your advising unit (i.e. Center for Academic Advising at the College, Honors, Athletics, Academic Advancement Program).
- All UCEAP courses count toward upper division units; therefore, even if your department denies your petition, you will still make progress toward your degree
- Study abroad is possible as soon as the summer after your first year through the Fall after your senior year. If going after senior year, meet your major advisor to adjust your graduation term.

MAJOR SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Lower Division Major Prep	No. The Anthropology Department only approves study abroad coursework for major electives, NOT specific subfield requirements.
Major Electives	Yes. Major electives can be fulfilled only if they carry upper division credit. We only accept <u>one</u> approved upper division abroad course toward the minor, and <u>no more than two</u> approved upper division courses toward major electives.
List of Pre-Approved Coursework?	Yes. The Anthropology department has a record of pre-approved coursework that is re-evaluated every five years. Please contact your major advisor to learn more.
