HOW TO STUDY ABROAD

1

RESEARCH

Review your remaining UCLA degree requirements (GE, pre-major, major, minor, foreign language, & upper division units).

2

IDENTIFY

Find UCEAP courses and identify options that are comparable to your degree requirements. They do not have to be an exact match.

3*

DISCUSS

If you have questions, meet the advisors at the International Education Office to review program details and locate syllabi.

4

PETITION

Petition with your Labor Studies advisor to apply study abroad coursework toward your degree requirements.

- * Pre-approvals are provided by the Labor Studies department. Therefore, you will know before your program starts whether you will be receiving major credit.
- * Study abroad is possible as soon as the summer after your first year through the Fall after your senior year. If going after senior year, meet your advisor to adjust your graduation term.
- * Petitions are valid for one academic quarter, so you will need to submit a new petition for your coursework before each quarter you plan on participating in study abroad.

MAJOR SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Lower Division Major Prep	Yes. However, LBR STD 10 must be completed at UCLA.
Major Electives	Yes. Major electives can be fulfilled abroad; however, the following courses must be completed at UCLA: LBR STD 101, Labor Studies course electives or Capstone courses abroad.
