HOW TO STUDY ABROAD



RESEARCH

Review your remaining UCLA degree requirements (GE, pre-major, major, minor, foreign language, & upper division units).



IDENTIFY

Find UCEAP courses and identify options that are comparable to your degree requirements. They do not have to be an exact match.



DISCUSS

If you have questions, meet the advisors at the International Education Office to review program details and locate syllabi.



PETITION

Meet with Statistics and Data Science Advisor to learn how to apply study abroad coursework toward your degree requirements.

- * The Department of Statistics grants pre-approvals for study abroad coursework. Course approvals are valid for one quarter.
- * Please note that Stats & DS coursework is sequential, so missing key courses can potentially delay graduation.
- * Most UCEAP courses count toward upper division units; therefore, even if your department denies your petition, you *will* still make progress toward your degree.
- * Study abroad is possible as soon as the summer after your first year through the Fall after your senior year. If going after senior year, meet your major advisor to adjust your graduation term.

MAJOR SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Lower Division Major Prep	Yes. Lower division coursework (e.g., Stats 20 or 21) can be completed outside UCLA with the course approval from the Vice Chair. Students should confirm with Math Department if they hope to take Math 31AB, 32AB, 33A abroad.
Major Electives	Yes. However, the following courses cannot be taken abroad: Stats 140XP, 141XP and M148.
List of Pre-Approved Coursework?	No. The Department of Statistics is not keeping a record of pre-approved study abroad coursework.

- * Study abroad courses are always reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Just because one course is approved for one quarter does not mean it would be approved for future quarter.
- * Syllabus must be submitted via Message Center to be considered to satisfy course credit.
