Per the [Traditional Study Abroad Pass/Fail Policy](#), this form is for the exclusive use of students planning to study abroad for the **fall or spring semester only**. Please be aware of the following:

- You are permitted to take one (1) course on a pass (S) / fail (U) basis when you study abroad for a full semester. If you take a course pass/fail, it will not under any circumstances fulfill major, minor, concentration, or NUPath requirements, and it will not be factored into your cumulative GPA.
- You must express interest in taking a course pass/fail before departure in your [GEO Application Portal](#).
- You must submit this form—completed and fully signed—to your Study Abroad Advisor no later than eight (8) weeks after the start of classes at your host institution.
- In order for a course to appear as a pass (S) on your Northeastern University transcript, you must earn the Northeastern-equivalent of a passing grade at your host institution. Grade equivalencies are listed under “Academics” on each [GEO Program Brochure](#).
- Students enrolled in the College of Engineering (COE) must complete coursework as outlined in a Plan of Study approved by an academic advisor. A maximum of 4 semester hours of pass/fail coursework is allowed per Study Abroad term. Only general electives taken outside COE may be taken on a pass/fail (S/U) grading basis.
