- 2. Remember to click the arrow next to the course code to see transfer equivalency information.
- 3. Students are expected to enroll in a combination of Major or Minor courses, Magis Core courses, and Elective courses at the level of instruction that corresponds to their term of study at Fairfield (i.e. Junior year, Junior level of instruction), and are expected to be academically engaged at least 4 days per week while abroad with the minimum equivalent of 15 credits.
- 4. Bring the completed form to an academic advisor for consultation and discussion. Completed forms should be scanned and uploaded to your study abroad application by December 1.
- 5. Listing a specific course does not guarantee enrollment in that course. Some reasons why you may not be approved for the course are: completion of pre-requisites, course isn't offered during that semester, enrollment caps, program restrictions, etc.
- 6. This form does not register you for courses and does not guarantee your selected classes will be offered during your term abroad. Being able to identify numerous course options that progress you academically will benefit your approval and make your final registration more viable.
- 7. If you are undeclared in Dolan or CAS, you will need to schedule a meeting with a study abroad advisor before completing this form.
