Incoming Exchange Student Application Materials

- Online OGE StudyAway Exchange Program Application
 - Undergraduate, Graduate, and Intensive English Language Exchange Options
- Undergraduate/ Graduate Application for Admission to UGA (no application fee)
 - Student must be in good standing and recommended by home university
- Official transcript or grade report in English from home university
- Proof of English language proficiency (minimum scores)
 - TOEFL iBT: TOEFL iBT: 4.0 recommended (80 recommended if taken prior to 2026)
 - IELTS: 6.5 (Graduate students: no sub-score below 6.0)
 - Cambridge International Examinations: Grade "D" (Undergraduate applicants only)
- Medical History and Immunization Forms
- Copy of Passport
- Course Request Form
- On-Campus Housing Application, if desired (online after acceptance)
- DS-2019 request for J-1 visa (submit upon request after acceptance)
